


		<p>present</p>	<p>Different ways we can show information on screen</p>

<p>Criteria</p>	<p>A way in which we can group items.</p>	 	
<p>Sort</p>	<p>Put objects together by the things they have in common.</p>		
<p>Collate</p>	<p>Collecting information (data)</p>		
<p>Record</p>	<p>Noting down the information (data) we have found.</p>		
<p>Pictogram</p>	<p>A graph that uses pictures to represent data.</p>		
<p>Question</p>	<p>Think about what our graphs e.g. pictograms show us.</p>
