

Year 6 Half Termly Newsletter April 2024

<u>English</u>

This term in English we will be completing a reciprocal reading sequence of learning around the text 'Thornhill'. We will be focusing on a variety of grammatical features and creating our own newspaper reports.

<u>Maths</u>

This term in Maths we will be focusing on geometry. Within this we will be learning about shapes, angle types, missing angles and using protractors. We will be using formal written methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division throughout.

<u>Topic</u>

This term in History we will be learning about World War II. We will find out all about this era of history, including key dates, what the events were and how/why it occurred. We will also be completing an Art unit all about our identity – this will focus on technical portrait skills and material layering.

Science

This term we will be learning about animals including humans. We will be looking at the human body including the circulatory system, how the heart works and how healthy/unhealthy lifestyles affect our body.

<u> PE</u>

This term in PE we will be learning about orienteering and striking/fielding through a range of different sporting activities. Please ensure your child has a full PE kit in school at all times.

Computing

This term in Computing we are focusing on the topic 'Coding and Computational thinking'. There will be lots of activities and discussions around what coding is used for in the modern world and how we can write code ourselves.

This term we will be learning about salvation based around the question Why did Jesus sacrifice himself for Christians?
