



Year 2 Half Termly Newsletter March 2022

English

This term in English we will be learning about the classic story of Paddington. We will be writing a character description and a letter to Aunt Lucy. We will also be looking at a non-fiction text about The Great Fire of London. We will write a diary entry and an information booklet about the fire.

Maths

This term in Maths we will be completing lots of work on Fractions. We will be recognising and finding fractions including $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{2}{4}$, $\frac{1}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ of a length, shape, set of objects and quantity. We will be writing simple fractions, for example $\frac{1}{2}$ of 6 = 3 and recognising that $\frac{1}{2}$ is equal to $\frac{2}{4}$.

History/D.T

In history, we will be learning about a significant event that happened in 1666. We will find out facts about The Great Fire of London and use our questioning skills to understand how these events impacted London today. In D.T, we will be making our own fire engines and finding out about mechanisms.

Science

This term we will be learning about Animals including Humans. We will discuss the importance of exercise and eating the right amounts of different types of food. We will use diagrams to show how animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults.

PE

This term in PE we will be learning football skills and dance. We will have two sessions, one indoor and one outdoor. Please ensure your child has a full PE kit in school at all times.

Computing

This term's topic is communication, networks and the internet. We will be recognising the common uses of technology beyond school and using technology safely and respectfully.

RE

This term we will be learning about Easter signs and symbols. We will also be finding out about multi-cultural Christianity.

Homework

Homework will be set on seesaw every Friday. Please ensure your child is able to log on and complete their tasks each week.
