English

This term we will be working hard to use the sounds we learn in our phonics, in our writing and to leave finger spaces between our words. We will also be looking at capital letters and full stops.

Within phonics and reading, we will be using the sounds we are learning and applying them to segment and blend new words we read according to Little Wandle.

Maths

This term in Maths we will be looking at number and place value up to 50. This will be working within numbers to 50 and recognising them before moving on to measurement.

Topic

This term we will conclude our learning about Queen Elizabeth II and will move on to Florence Nightingale in history and how she was important for the world and nursing. We will also be developing our Design & technology skills to make a kite about an inspirational person in our lives.

Science

After concluding our learning on materials by planning and performing an investigation, we will start our new unit – plants.

PE

This term in PE we will be learning some of the core skills needed in PE, as well as how attack & defend during sports.

Computing

We are looking at spreadsheets and databases. We will also continue to embed online safety and the skills recently taught in writing and presenting.

RE

Our big question for this term is 'Who is Jewish and how do they live?'. This unit is a double unit and will take us up to Summer term.

This term's interventions have now started. If you received a letter from your child's class teacher, please endeavour to send your child in to school when invited.

<u>Homework</u>

Please ensure homework books are sent to school so that this term's homework grid can be sent out. You should aim to complete at least two pieces of homework before the deadline.
