## Prior Learning

What can you see when you go for a walk in Autumn, Winter, Spring and Summer?  
 What should you wear when it is really hot?

## Key Vocabulary

**Change:** An act or process through which something becomes different.

**Variation:** A slightly different form or version of something.

**Winter:** The coldest season of the year.

**Autumn:** The leaves turn orange, red and yellow.

**Spring:** When plants start to grow and it starts to get warmer.

**Summer:** The hottest season of the year.

## Key Facts

- 1) The four seasons are Autumn, Winter, Spring and Summer.
- 2) In Autumn the leaves are yellow, orange and red and the leaves fall off the trees.
- 3) In Winter it is very cold and sometimes it snows. We can build snowmen.
- 4) In Spring plants and trees grow new leaves and flowers and it gets warmer. New animals are born like lambs and chicks.
- 5) In Summer it is hot and the sun shines. We see lots of bright coloured flowers. Lots of people have barbeques, go to the beach and we can play outside more.
- 6) The days are longer in Summer and shorter in Winter. It goes dark earlier when it is Winter.
