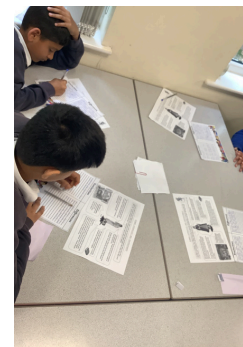
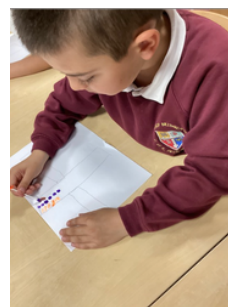


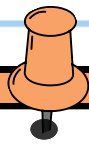
RE SUPER LEARNING DAY - CHRISTIANITY AROUND THE WORLD

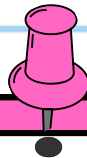

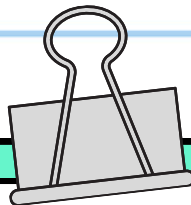

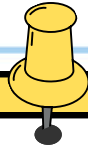
ATTENDANCE MATTERS

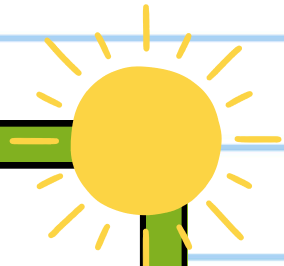
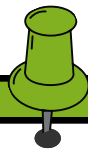


STAFFING LIST 24/25
