English

This term in English we will be completing a non-chronological report about Kenya. We will be using all of our knowledge from our geography topic to support us. We will also be completing a reciprocal unit using the text Traction Man by Mini Grey. We will be writing our own adventure stories.

Maths

This term in Maths we will be completing lots of work on Money. We will be finding different combinations of coins that equal the same amount and solving problems including giving change. We will also be completing work on Multiplication and Division using our 2s, 5s and 10s to recall multiplication and division facts.

Geography/Art

This term in geography we will be learning about Kenya. We will find out about the human and physical features of Kenya and how these are similar/different to Bolton. In Art, we will be finding out about the artist Steven Brown. We will use various techniques to create a McCoo in the style as the artist studied.

Science

This term we will be learning about Living Things and Their Habitats. We will identify the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food, air, oxygen, shelter). We will also describe how animals obtain their food and use food chains to identify different sources of food.

PE

This term in PE we will be learning football skills and gymnastics. We will have two sessions, one indoor and one outdoor. Please ensure your child has a full PE kit in school at all times.

Computing

This term's topic is spreadsheets. We will use technology to create, organise and store information. You will find the knowledge organiser for this unit on seesaw.

RE

This term we will be learning about Jesus being a friend to everyone.
