



Year 2 Half Termly Newsletter November 2021

English

This term in English we will be completing a reciprocal sequence of learning about a story called Beegu. We will be writing a diary entry in role as the main character. In Phonics we will be working on consolidation of phase 5 graphemes and spelling rules for year 2.

Maths

This term in Maths we will be completing lots of work on addition and subtraction and using the column method with exchanging. We will continue our weekly practice of our times tables including our 2s, 5s, 10s and 3s. We will also be doing lots of work on measurements: money.

Topic

This term in DT we will be designing and making our own boxes to hold bars of soap just like William Lever designed. We will be moving on to our new geography topic about Kenya.

Science

This term we will be learning about Living Things and Their Environments. We will discuss the difference between things that are living, things that are dead/have died and things that have never been alive/lived. We will also discuss/learn the names of animals and their offspring and match them to their habitats.

PE

This term in PE we will be learning hockey skills and gymnastics. We will have two sessions, one indoor and one outdoor. Please ensure your child has a full PE kit in school at all times.

Computing

This term's topic is Writing & Presenting. We will be learning how to set out different types of documents and learning new ways of formatting text including bold, underline and alignment. Knowledge organisers for this topic are available on Seesaw.

RE

This term we will be learning about Christmas and the good news this brings. We will study the key events from the Christmas story.

Homework

Homework will be set on seesaw every Friday. Please ensure your child is able to log on and complete their tasks each week.
