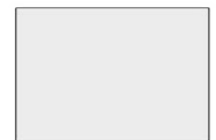
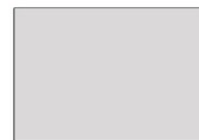
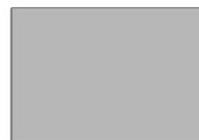
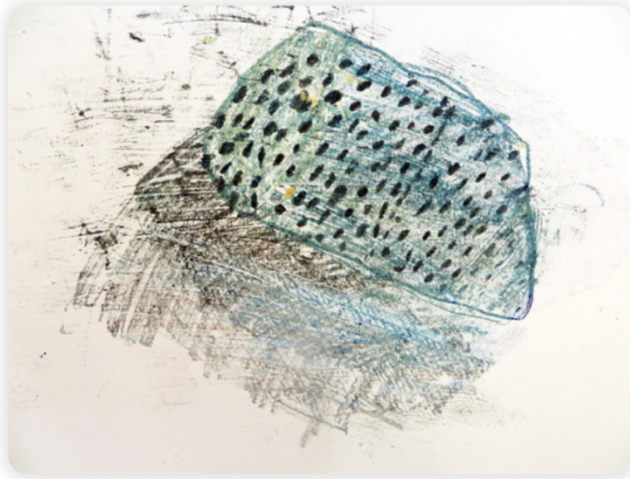
### Art & Design Concepts

## Year 3 Art & Design: Cloth, Thread, Paint

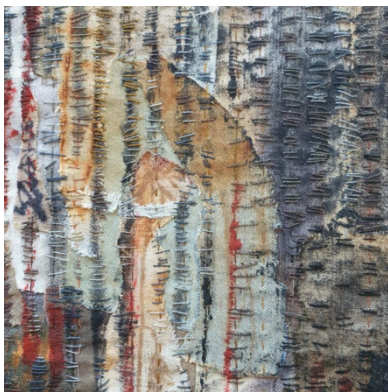
### Art & Design Concepts
