

Year 2 Half Termly Newsletter April 2024

English This term in English we will be reading the story 'The Last Wolf'. We will be reading all about Little Red and her adventures through the forest. We will be able to retell the story of Little red including interesting adjectives and new vocabulary. Then we will then move onto The Bear and the Piano.

<u>Maths</u> This term in Maths we will be focusing on measurement. We will be learning how to measure length and height using centre metres and metres. Weight using grams and kilo grams. Capacity using Miller litres and Litres. Finally, temperature using degrees.

History This term in History we will be learning about the Great fire of London! We will be looking at the Timeline of events from the fire. We will also be looking at how fire services haved changed over time.

<u>Science</u> This term we'll be learning about Animals including Humans. We will be discussing the importance of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food and taking care of our basic hygiene.

PE This term in PE we will work on Athletics using equipment. We will be improving our jumping, running and throwing skills.

Computing

This term we will learning about coding. We will be learning about algorithms and they are implemented as programmes. We will be creating and debugging simple programmes and using logical reasoning to predict the behaviours of simple programmes.

RE

This term we will be focusing on the question 'What is the 'good news' Christians believe Jesus brings?' We will tell stories from the Bible and link it to the good news.

Homework - will be given at the beginning of each half term. The children will be given 6 pieces of homework and can choose at least 2 to complete. The more they complete the more chance they have to win a prize. Spelling will be given weekly and reading books should be read every day.
